CBH/SAA Petition #1-18

“Problem” currently reflects;

“That all CBH/SAA State Tournaments have the same age categories set forth by NFAA. Which would be the indoor, 900, field and the broad head.”

Areas of the CBH/SAA Bylaws & Standing Rules where this would be amended;

Page 9, Standing Rules, Article I, Tournaments

Currently states “Participants in CBH/SAA tournaments, except the State Broadhead and 3D Unmarked, must be a member of CBH/SAA and NFAA or CBH/SAA and NAA and a resident of or has declared residency in (3-05) California at the time of the tournament to participate for awards. Those shooting the State Broadhead and the 3D Unmarked must be a CBH/SAA Associate Member or NFAA/CBH/SAA Member. Residency requirements apply to Broadhead and 3D Unmarked, as well. All competitors must be prepared to show proof of membership.”

Page 9, Standing Rules, Article I, Section A, Tournament Shooting Styles

Currently states “#1. A. NFAA Rules shall apply to all shooting styles, except at the State Broadhead and 3D Unmarked.”

.....
Page 17, Standing Rules, Article I, Section E, CBH/SAA State Broadhead Championship Tournament

Currently states “#1. This tournament is designed to appeal to the bowhunter as opposed to the tournament archer. It is designed to offer the hunter some benefits without his/her becoming entangled in the aspects of a Field tournament. NFAA rules do not apply to this event.”

Page 18, Standing Rules, Article I, Section E, 5B. Divisions and Styles of Shooting

Currently states “1) Divisions

- a) Seniors (65+)
- b) Adult (18-64) Male and Female
- c) Young Adult (ages 15-17) Male and Female
- d) Youth (ages 12-14) Male and Female

2) Styles

- a) Sight (S)
- b) Non-Sight (NS)
- c) Release (R)
- d) Recurve (Rc) – Adults and Seniors only
- e) Traditional (T) – Adults and Seniors only

Page 18, Standing Rules, Article I, Section E, 5D. Tackle;

Currently states “1) One stabilizer not over 12 inches, allowed

2) Bow quivers are allowed in all styles

3) No magnifying scopes are allowed.

12) Longbows: Any type of arrow shaft is allowed

13) Longbows: Must be shot off the shelf.

14) Clickers allowed in all styles

Additional areas that were not mentioned that would be affected is the State 3D Unmarked Championship Tournament. Would also need to amend;

Page 20, Standing Rules, Article I, Section F, General Working Mechanics;

Currently states “3. Participants must be a NFAA/CBH/SAA member or a CBH/SAA Associate Member and a resident of the state of California at the time of registration to participate for awards.”.

Page 21, Standing Rules, Article I, Section F, General Working Mechanics;

Currently states “8. Divisions and Awards;

b. Adult divisions will consist of:

Fixed Sight Fingers, Moveable Sight Fingers, Fixed Sight Release, Moveable Sight Release, Non-Sight Fingers, Longbow & Recurve.

c. Young Adult, Youth and Cub-divisions will consist of:

Release Sight, Non-sight and Traditional
